








INTRODUCTION






During job interviews, there are certain types of questions that employers tend to ask. One of the most common interview questions is, *What is your greatest strength?* which is often preceded or followed by, *What is your greatest weakness?* When answering questions about your strengths and weaknesses, always keep the job description in mind.

When addressing questions about your strengths, focus on strengths you have that are required for the job. For example, if a job requires a lot of work on team projects, you might say that you are a clear communicator who can work with diverse groups of people.








9.2. PRESENTATION LETTER




